ABOUT THE FESTIVAL



The INGED Drama Festival aims to help students enjoy English by engaging in creative drama performances. It provides a platform for students to showcase their skills in English through acting, singing, and teamwork.

How to Apply as a Participating School

1

Eligibility

Only schools with teachers who are active INGED members can apply.



2

Quota


The first 10 eligible schools will be accepted to the festival. INGED reserves the right to revise this number based on organizational capacity.

Application Form


Schools must complete the official Google Application Form provided on the INGED website or social media.



4

Deadline

The deadline for application is announced each year. Early applications are encouraged.



5

IMPORTANT

After acceptance, schools must submit a list of student names and their roles, together with a picture of each actor and actress, no later than two weeks before the festival to both INGED and the hosting school.



How to Apply to be a Host Institution

Each year, the **INGED Drama Festival** is held at a different host school.

The administrators of the schools who wish to host the event should send a formal letter to INGED including the following:





Handle all technical arrangements (lighting, sound, microphones)

Provide a suitable performance venue (stage, audience seating, backstage)





Event Preparation & Organization

Coordinate rehearsal scheduling and stage management



Selection Process

The INGED Board will review applications and announce the selected host school.



Hosting the Event

Welcome and guide guest schools during the event,



INGED Responsibilities

INGED will assist the host school with jury selection and overall coordination but is not responsible for local logistics.

INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS

By participating, all participating schools accept the following terms and conditions:

The participating schools will be held responsible for the behavior and manners of the parents.

The participating schools which disrupt the festival or do not abide by these terms may be disqualified from future events or organizations for a duration to be determined by INGED.

Responsibility for all stage decorations and costumes falls on the participating schools.

Performance Rules

1

Each play: max 15 minutes

2

Time between performances: 10 minutes max

3

Costumes, stage decor, and rehearsals are the responsibility of the participating school

4

All technical equipment (lighting, sound) will be managed by the host school

5

Adherence to performance time limitations will affect the jury evaluation.


